Home Learning Ideas

- Go for a walk using an OS map- what are the features of an OS map?
- Create your own map of somewhere real or imaginary- make sure to include a key!
- Do some painting- how many different ways can you apply the paint on the page?
- Research what abstract art is and create your own piece
- Research artist Jackson Pollock and discover why his work is so famous
- Set up a plant experiment at home to discover what plants need to survive and grow
- Have a go at growing plants at home- think about what you need to do to make sure they grow! You could then make a growing diary
