## <u>Science</u> <u>States of Matter</u>

#### Throughout this science topic, we will learn about these key ideas:

Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases



Identify different materials and compare how particles behave relating to whether they are solids, liquids or gases

Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius. (°C)



We will be exploring these key principles through scientific investigations that we will design ourselves. We will plan a question to investigate and then set about preparing our enquiry.

We will also learn about the basic stages of the water cycle process.





Throughout our English learning this half term we will be immersing ourselves in the wonderful world of <u>Roald Dahl.</u> We will read *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* as our main class text, explore extracts of it within guided reading and base our writing unit around a scene from the book too. Our focus will be on how we develop characters with our words, and also how the use of speech can give a wider insight into their personalities. This will support the work we are doing within our art and animation work too!

Towards the end of the half term, we will also become news reporters and write articles sharing the news of the winning ticket finders. We are going to be recording these in new reporter style and sharing them with Year 3.

## <u>Art</u>

## Quentin Blake

This term we will be exploring Quentin Blake's unique style. We will look at how he uses different facial expressions to display character's mood. We will also revise sketching techniques, discuss his preference for light, free work and we will study his work practising his style.



We will then use our studies to create our own characters and settings for our animations. We aim to tell their story by sharing key characteristics told within the iconic book—*Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*.
