

PSHE

Jigsaw Jenie will support our PSHE learning this half term during our focus on 'Relationships'. We will be looking at relationships, who we have relationships with and how to maintain them.

Key vocabulary - friends, family, manage feelings, positive, negative

Physical Development Ball skills:

We will develop our ball skills through the topic of 'minibeasts'. We will develop fundamental ball skills such as rolling and receiving a ball, throwing to a target, bouncing, and catching, dribbling with feet, and kicking a ball. We will be given opportunities to work independently and with a partner.

Games:

We will develop our understanding of playing games through the topic of 'transport'. We will practise and further develop fundamental movement skills through games. We will also learn how to score and play by the rules, how to work with a partner and begin to understand what a team is, as well as learning how to behave when winning and losing.

Our PE days will be Monday and Friday, so please ensure that PE kits comes into school on Monday, they will be sent home on a Friday.



Maths

This half term we will be looking at numbers up to 20, learning the order and knowing what number comes next. We will be looking at the composition of numbers up to 20.

We will also introduce the concept of first, then and now using mathematical stories for addition and subtraction, i.e. First I had 4 sweets, then I got 2 more, now I have 6.


Expressive Arts and Design

Our creative learning this half term will be focused on painting. We will be exploring what is meant by colour, identify colours and know the three primary colours Red, Blue and Yellow.

We will explore colour mixing and identify the new colours we create when mixing two colours together.

We will also know the way paint is applied will alter the effect it creates, such as using a finger, paintbrush, or sponge.

Communication & Language



Through practicing our communication skills, we will be able to talk about our decisions in our learning, our design choices, what we plan to do next and review the learning we have done.

Literacy

In literacy we will practice retelling stories, identifying the start, middle and end of a story. We will be focussing on writing for purpose and understanding how writing is used to convey meaning. We will continue to write sentences and begin to extend them with connectives, such as and.

Phonics - Daily Practice

In phonics we have learnt our set 1 sounds and most of our set 2 sounds, moving through our Read Write Inc Red Ditty books.

We will be focussing on building our blending skills to read sentences with some fluency, e.g.
