Foundation - Home Learning ideas!



Make a checklist of all the different ways you travel this half term. Have you travelled in/on/by a car, bus, train, bike, walk, jog, scooter? You could take photos of you moving/travelling these ways.



Practice saying and writing the sounds we've learnt so far: m, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c, **k**, u, b, f, e, l, h, sh, r, j, v, y, w, th, z, ch, qu, x, ng, nk, ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, oo (book), ar, or, air, ir, ou, oy.



You could create a treasure hunt for your adult at home, giving them instructions and clues on how to find what you have hidden. Your adult could create a treasure hunt for you, giving you instructions to follow.



Can you write a sentence describing the vehicles at your home, eg. The car is red. You could even use the word and, e.g. The bike is black and blue



You could make a list of all the different places you've visited in UK or other countries. Do you have photos of these places?



Can you write the numbers 1-20? Practice counting to 20 as much as you can. You could count how many vegetables are on your plate at dinner.

Can you add two numbers together to find the total? Roll 2 dice and add the two numbers together. You could even write the number sentence.

e.g.

$$4 + 2 = 6 \quad 3 + 1 = 4$$

$$5 + 5 = 10 \quad 2 + 6 = 8$$
