Research some famous pirates to teach us about.

Create a wanted poster for a missing pirate! Think about how you would describe what they look like, how they dress and their character.

Paint or draw a picture of a deserted island. This is *your* island; you can have anything on it!

Imagine you found a washed up bottle on the beach and when you pick it up, there is a letter inside. What does it say? Who is it from?

Design a raft that you could build if you were stuck on an island.

Experiment using different materials to create your own pirate ship. Remember the investigations we did in class when we made a boat for Paddington.

Create a treasure map using clues and symbols for a friend or family member to follow. Will you hide some treasure at the end?

Research all of the different things that you might find on a pirate ship. What are they called? What are they used for?

Visit Old Harry Rocks with an adult. Why are these rocks famous? Why are they called Old 'Harry' Rocks?

Draw a colourful parrot for your shoulder. How many colours can you use? What is your parrot called?

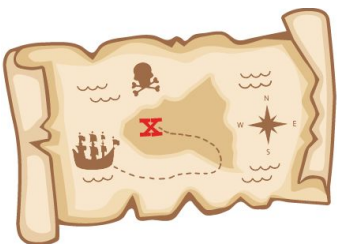


Create a pirate wordsearch or crossword for a friend or family member to complete.
