## Headteacher's Update

I am very much looking forward to yet another exciting and busy term with lots of opportunities for us to come together, including the long awaited return of Parent Share. We are all very much looking forward to Sports Day on the 29th June, the gate to the field (year 2) gate will be opened at 1.05pm and closed at 1.25 pm. We will start promptly at 1.30 pm, should you arrive after this time please go the school office. Further details of what the children will need will be sent out nearer the time. I am sure this will be a fabulous event, we just need to hope for dry weather.

## <u>Your Time!</u>

This half term we have introduced Your Time to the children. I am sure some of your children have been telling you about it, as there has been great excitement

around school. We have reflected on feedback from parents and children on how we give recognition to pupils who make good learning and behaviour choices consistently.

Your Time works in conjunction with our Behaviour Responsibility Ladder.

The children start each week by choosing what activity they would like to do for 30 minutes on a Friday. They are given a wide range of activities to choose from including singing, dance, board games, football etc

During the week if a pupil doesn't make good choices in their learning or behaviour the consequence may lead to them losing Your Time in blocks of 5 minutes. We have reviewed our ladder to ensure that it will be used consistently by all staff. The children will receive a reminder, a warning and final warning which will include a few minutes time out to reflect and will be reminded that if they continue, they are choosing to lose 5 minutes Your Time.

### <u>Jigsaw</u>

Our PHSE curriculum focus this half term is Changing

**me** and the focus on coping positively with change. During this term the children will learn how to manage their emotions during times of change and respect that all of us have different emotions. All our children have a weekly PHSE lesson linked to this theme and the children are reminded of the key skills throughout all their learning. Each week we have a focused assembly where we discuss how everyone is unique and special and this should be celebrated. We will continue to ensure that all children have someone that they can ask for help from if they are worried. As part of these assemblies class teachers nominate children who have modelled the key skill that we are looking for.

### Playground Games

Our children are really enjoying a range of games with our new playground equipment. It has been wonderful to see so many of our children play games and showing some determination when perfecting a particular skill. Whilst on the playground with children, some of them have being setting themselves mini challenges. We will continue to work with the children in developing their knowledge of games that they can play together.
