Dear Parents/ Carers,

As Christmas is fast approaching, we wanted to give you some information regarding our plans for the celebrations in school this year.

Over the coming weeks we will be preparing for Christmas and all the children will be involved in making decorations for the school. The Friends of Henbury have arranged for Hope Farm to donate a Christmas Tree which is wonderful and we will be inviting the children to help decorate the tree with us.

#### **The Christmas Nativity**

This year we will be performing the production "It's a Miracle " and the children have already been busy learning the songs. The performances will be held on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> December at 6pm and Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> December at 9.00 am. **Two tickets per family** will be available and everyone attending must have their own ticket due to the Health and Safety regulations within the church. We will be sending out a link to a Google form where you will be able to make your request for tickets. The tickets will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. The form will be available to complete from 6pm on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> November until 9am on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> November. Following this we will work through the requests in order and in the event of tickets not being available for your chosen performance we will

allocate tickets to the other performance. Tickets will be sent home with the children on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> November. It is important that you bring the tickets to your chosen performance as unfortunately we will be unable to permit people in without a ticket.


A separate Costume letter is being sent out, but we ask that they are in school by Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> November for our dress rehearsal.
